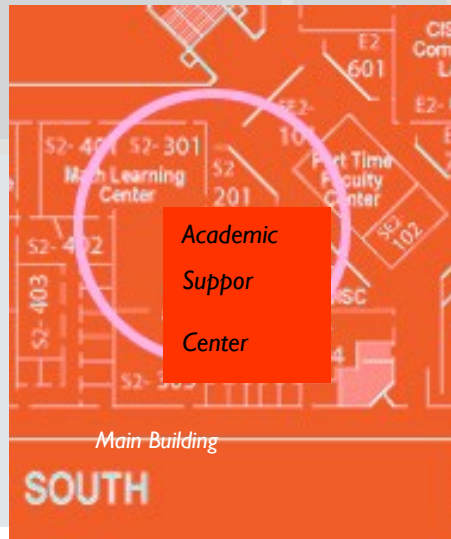

Free Tutoring!

The ASC Tutoring Center is home to Mission College's general Tutorial Center.

Tutoring is available for all subjects (for Math tutoring please visit the Math Lab, S2-401). You must be referred by an instructor or counselor to register for the free tutoring service.

Tutoring is provided at no charge by qualified, trained tutors.

- Tutoring is free.
- Tutoring is available for a variety of classes ranging from accounting, English writing, foreign languages, humanities, sciences, to vocational nursing.
- Appointments and drop-ins are available.
- Appointments can be scheduled online from the ASC website.

Our tutors can give you feedback on your work, help you understand assignments, and provide you strategies for improving your skills.

Study Skills Courses

- **IS 949**

For students who need help with study strategies like preparing for tests, taking notes in class, studying from textbooks, or scheduling time better.

- **IS 950**

For students who need help with academic skills related to other courses they are taking at Mission College. Topics may include learning strategies, writing, reading, oral/aural skills, and/or study skills. Multimedia and online activities. Instructors available.

ESL Courses

The ESL courses help students improve their ESL skills. The lab courses are a half unit courses that requires 24 hours of program study. Students in the ESL lab can access:

Reading Courses
