



Magazines, Journals and Databases Online

The Library subscribes to several electronic databases. These databases contain millions of newspaper, magazine and journal articles, information from reference books as well as transcripts from radio and television programs. Many of the articles are full-text with complete graphics. They are available through the library's Web page.

ON-CAMPUS ACCESS

To access the databases from any Mission College campus computer, go to:

- Click on a database title to search.

OFF-CAMPUS ACCESS

To access the databases from off campus you need the following:

- Your Mission College student I.D. number.
- A computer with either Microsoft Internet Explorer or Netscape Navigator.
- An Internet connection.

DETERMINING IF MISSION COLLEGE LIBRARY HAS ACCESS TO A PARTICULAR NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINE OR JOURNAL ELECTRONICALLY

The databases to which the library subscribes contain millions of full-text articles. To determine if a particular newspaper, magazine or journal is available electronically, use the ***Full Text Electronic Journal List*** link near the top of the ***Magazines, Journals, and Databases Online*** page. Type in the name of your publication, if the newspaper, magazine or journal is available the database in which it is included will be listed, along with the coverage dates.

DATABASES - GENERAL INTEREST

These databases mostly contain magazine and newspaper articles, many in full text.

CQ Researcher

A weekly magazine focusing on current and controversial topics. Each issue includes complete summaries, pros and cons and bibliographies on one subject.

eLibrary

Full-text transcripts of radio and TV programs, books, magazines, and more. Searching by topic uses natural language or Boolean logic. Suggested reading level for each article is given on the "Results List" page.

Custom Newspapers

Twenty-five million full-text articles from over 124 newspapers.

Expanded Academic ASAP

A general-purpose periodicals and newspaper index covering a wide range of topics. Many articles are full-text. Searching by subject enables the user to narrow the search by subject subdivisions for more specific results.

Ethnic NewsWatch

Full-text, general reference database of articles from minority and ethnic magazines, newspapers and journals. Many articles in Spanish.


FACTS.com

Brings together complete content from the *Facts On File World News Digest* and a live newsfeed from Reuters®.

Onefile

Periodical and news information. Includes more than 6,000 full-text titles; five newspaper indexes — a total of nearly 10,000 titles in all — with more than 25 years of backfile coverage from 1980 to present.
