NATIONAL FIRE CODES ONLINE

The library subscribes to the online version of the National Fire Codes. This subscription differs from other library subscriptions in that a NFPA ID number and password are required and only one user is allowed to access the database at a time. The ID number and password can be obtained from a FTS instructor or from the librarian at the Library's Information Desk. **(Please remember to LOG OUT when finished to allow others to sign-in.)**

MAGAZINES AND JOURNALS IN PRINT

The library subscribes to three fire technology related magazines in print. They are The California Fire Service, Fire Engineering, and NFPA Journal. The current year's issues are located in the periodicals section of the library. Ask for back issues at the Circulation Desk.

MAGAZINES, JOURNALS, AND DATABASES ONLINE

The library also provides access to online collections (databases) of articles. These databases can be accessed from the library's Web page *Magazines, Journals, and Databases Online* at http://www.missioncollege.org/lib/database_top.html. (Note: In order to access databases from off campus, you must have a current student or staff I.D. entered into the library's computer system.)

Expanded Academic ASAP

Includes magazine, journal and newspaper articles; covers a broad range of topics; many articles available in full-text.

eLibrary

Includes the full text of magazine, journal, and newspaper articles, plus television transcripts and other materials; covers a broad range of topics.

FACTS.com

Includes the World News Digest from 1940 to present.

INTERNET RESOURCES

California Code of Regulations – <http://www.calregs.com/>

This is the electronic version of the code. From the welcome page choose California Code of Regulations from the left margin. There are slight variations from the print version of Barclay's Official California Code of Regulations. For example, Title 8 is listed as Industrial Relations not CAL/OSHA; Title 22 is listed as Social Security not Toxic Substances; and Title 24 is not available. If you choose Agency List for CCR from the welcome page you can browse the alphabetical list of agencies.

To do a more specific search, click on the link *Go to a Specific Section* near the bottom right of the page. Type the title in the first box. If you do not know the specific section leave the second box blank and type your search term(s) in the third box.
